

Reading from St. Thomas Aquinas "The Names of GOD" (1225-74)

Even the very ones who were experienced concerning DIVINITY, such as the apostles and prophets, praise God as the Cause of all things from the many things caused. They praise God as good (Luke 18); as beautiful (Song of Songs 1); as wise (Job 9); as beloved (Song of Songs 5); as God of gods (Ps 50); as holy of holies (Dan. 9); as eternal (Bar. 4); as manifest (Job 14); as the cause of the ages (Eccles. 24); as the bestower of life (Acts 17); as wisdom (1 Cor. 1); as mind or intellect (Ps. 29); as reason (Is. 63:"I who speak justice"); as the knower (2 Tim. 2); as the one possessing in advance all the treasures of universal knowledge (Col. 2); as virtue (1 Cor. 1); as the powerful (Ps.89); as King of kings (Apoc.19); as the Ancient of days (Dan.7); as without age and unchanging (James 1); as salvation (Matt.1); as justice, or as one justifying, as it were, deliverance or redemption according to another translation (1 Cor.1); as magnitude exceeding all things (Job 23); as in the light breeze (3 Kings 19).

And they say that God is even in minds or hearts (Eph.3); in spirits (Wis. 7); and in bodies (1 Cor.6); in heaven and on earth (Jer.23); and at the same time in the same place, that is with regard to the same material, they say that the same one is worldly, and is, in the world (John 1); involved in the world (Eccles.24); above the world (Is.66); and supercelestial, or above the heavens (Ps.113: "The Lord on high above the nations whose glory is above all the skies"); supersubstantial (Matt.6); the sun (Mal. 4); a constellation, that is, a star (Apoc. 22); fire (Deut. 4); water (John 4); air (Joel 2); and dew (Hos.14); cloud (Hos.6); stone Ps. 118); rock (1 Cor. 10); and all the other beings attributed to God as cause.

And the DIVINE ONE is none of these being insofar as GOD surpasses all things.

May we learn to be still and sit in silence to hear that infinite spark of energy running through us, binding us together as one.


